Worship and music are inseparable terms at Westminster. The Westminster Choir is an auditioned group of adult volunteers and professional singers. The choir sings in worship each Sunday and for special services as assigned throughout the liturgical year. In addition, the choir presents sacred masterworks annually, most often with orchestra. The choir has toured to the United Kingdom and Europe, most recently in July 2018. The choir will travel to Iceland and the UK in 2023.
